Classes & Lecture:

Helen Squire

An entrepreneur since 1973 when *Quilt In: Lessons* Supplies*Designs* by Helen Squire was incorporated, Helen has been an active participant in the growth of the quilt industry as a designer, lecturer, teacher and television consultant. For the past 10 years, she has written "Helen's Hints: Creative Quilting Designs" for *American Quilter* magazine, and is best known for her "Dear Helen" quilting books—her eighth in the series was recently published: "Quilting UFO's with Helen's Hints". Now retired from her position as vice-president of sales and marketing for the *American Quilter's Society*, Helen continues to design, teach, and lecture while still maintaining a home and studio in Paducah, Kentucky.

Easy-to-Crete Wholecloth Quilts (2 half days)

Whether you plan to quilt later by hand or machine, you can "practice with a purpose" in class as you choose patterns that look good together from a multitude of quilting stencils and printed patterns. Design a quilted wall hanging that will showcase a medallion, blocks or mitered borders. Learn to recognize principles of good design, various methods used for marking quilts, and how to make a quick, simple edging for this project.

Sue Nickels

Sue has been quilting for over 30 years, starting by hand and gradually focusing on machine work. She has taught machine techniques for over 20 years. An internationally known teacher and author of two quilting books, Sue has also been a judge for many quilt shows, most recently part of the team judging the 2009 IQA show in Houston, Texas. Sue's priority in the workshops she teaches is to provide a relaxed environment for students to learn machine techniques that are timesaving. She emphasizes the best quality workmanship, never compromising quality for speed!

Machine Quilting Basics (beginner/intermediate)

In this basic workshop, learn all aspects needed to master machine quilting. Start with a discussion on machine quilting supplies, including thread, needles and notions. Next, practice the basic techniques of straight line and free-motion machine quilting on small quilt packages. After learning the skills to feel confident with these techniques, Sue will demonstrate how to successfully baste, package and machine quilt the actual quilt. Go home feeling confident to quilt any size and style quilt. Many quilts will be shown for inspiration. With Sue's patient guidance learn all the basic skills needed to master machine quilting on your home sewing machine.

Machine Quilting for Today's Quilts (lecture)

Sue will share through slides her progression from hand quilter to the machine quilter she is today. This personal journey includes slides of her and her sister's, Pat Holly, quilts as well quilts from machine quilters who have influenced the current machine quilting trends. Sue will bring a selection other quilts to share and provide time for discussion at the end, so bring your questions about machine quilting.

Pat Yamin

With over 36 years of quilting, Pat has amassed a large collection of antique quilts, tops and blocks. Her collections are frequently sought after for trunk shows and have been exhibited at major quilt shows across the country. Pat's background led her start her company, COME QUILT WITH ME, in 1981. It has evolved from a mail-order company to a major manufacturing concern. Her antique quilts serve as a design inspiration for the acrylic templates her company manufactures. Pat has appeared on numerous television programs, most recently, the *American Quilter* on "Lifetime TV". She has also been a frequent guest on the *Martha Stewart Living* radio show. She travels extensively to national quilting events and is frequently asked to teach, lecture and judge. She lives in Brooklyn, NY, with her husband.
